

Regarding class methods in Fall semester of 2022

【Important Notes】

- Students should wear masks (non-woven masks are recommended).
- Disinfect their hands at the entrance to buildings and classrooms.
- Measures such as opening diagonal windows should be taken to ensure adequate ventilation of the room.
- Students who are ill or have a fever or other cold symptoms will not be allowed to attend classes in person. They also will not be allowed to use the graduate student rooms.

1. Classes in Fall Semester of 2022

In accordance with the University's policy, classes will be held mainly face-to-face, with thorough infection prevention measures in place. However, for reasons of educational effectiveness and of the effects of COVID19, each class will be conducted in a different method.

Please be sure to check each syllabus and BEEF for details of face-to-face, online or hybrid classes.

Also, please note that there may be changes to the method in which classes are delivered during the academic year. Please check the syllabus and BEEF as well as follow the instructions of your lecturers.

If you wish to take online classes at the University, you can use the classroom as an access point.

2. About Graduate Student Rooms

The use of graduate student rooms is permitted, provided that infection prevention measures are taken. However, failure to comply with the following rules may result in the prohibition of the use. Further restrictions on the use may be imposed depending on the future COVID19 situation.

- * Please refrain from unnecessary use of the room and return home as soon as you have achieved the purpose of your use.
- * When using the rooms, please make sure to write your student number, date and time of entry and exit, and room number in the user list at the entrance to the Academic Affairs Office on the 1st floor.

- * In principle, doors should be left open for ventilation purpose, and windows should be open except when it is raining or windy.
- * The number of people who can use the room at the same time should be about one third of the capacity to avoid crowding. (If there are too many people using the room, please arrange your own time to avoid crowding.)
- * **No eating** (except for drinks) and **no talking** in the graduate student rooms.
