
Application Guidelines for Research Students Admission in October 2022

Those who wish to conduct research on specific specialized matters at the Graduate School may apply for Research Student program, regardless of their nationality, if they meet the following application qualifications and obtain prior approval for their application from the faculty member for whom they wish to receive research guidance.



2. Eligibility for Admission

- (1) Those who have completed an undergraduate program in Japan or who are expected to do so by September 30, 2022.
- (2) Those who have completed 16 years of education outside Japan or who are expected to do so by September 30, 2022.
- (3) Those who have reached the age of 22 at the time of September 20, 2022 and are recognized as being academically eligible for graduate studies by GSICS.
 - *All applicants in the eligibility category (3) must inquire about their eligibility prior to submitting their application by contacting GSICS Academic Affairs Office.

3. Application Documents

	Documents	Contents
(1)	Application Form	A portrait photograph (size 4.5 cm \times 3.5 cm) taken within the last three months should be glued.
(2)	Research Proposal	English: more than 600 words / Japanese: more than 1200 words
(3)	Curriculum Vitae	Form enclosed
(4)	Official Transcript	Certificate of academic grades from the latest university attended
(5)	Official Certificate of Graduation (or Expected Graduation) and Degree	Official certificate of graduation and bachelor's / master's / doctoral degree from the latest university attended
(6)	Entrance Examination Fee 9,800 yen	After completing the payment, attach a copy of your bank transfer receipt or transfer request form with the application. Request for a payment slip to the GSICS Academic Affairs Office, in case transferring in Japan.
(7)	Copy of Passport	Photocopy of the passport biographical information page

- If the certificates are in a language other than Japanese or English, a Japanese or English translation should be attached.
- ※Applicants who have or will have graduated from a university in China, if admitted, must apply for their bachelor's / master's / doctoral degree provided by China Academic degrees and Graduate Education Development Center (CDGDC) without delay. Details will be communicated to each successful applicant in this category after the admission decision.
- *Applicants who live in Japan must submit a copy of the certificate of residence (must be made within 30 days prior to the date of submission) or an alternative document.
- ※ If you belong to a company (including public offices), please submit Job Holder Recognizance (prescribed form).

4. Application Deadline

Application documents must reach GSICS by post between May 20, 2022 and May 27, 2022.

5. Application Process and Results

The admission decision will be made primarily on the basis of the application documents submitted and an interview. Applicants who live overseas may be exempted from interviews. An official letter of the examination result will be sent by post after July 8, 2022. No telephone and email inquiries will be accepted.

6. Registration

Admission will be on October 1, 2022.

Research students are not able to obtain a master's degree nor a doctoral degree. In principle, the period of research is either six months or one year. An extension request may be granted for a maximum period of one year. The maximum period of being a research student in total is two years.

All entering students are required to register at the GSICS Academic Affairs Office from the middle of September 2022.

Fees (subject to change)
Entrance Fee: 84,600 yen

Tuition Fee: 356,400 yen/year (178,200 yen/semester)

8. Additional Information

- (1) Research students are not able to obtain a master's degree nor doctoral degree.
- (2) Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
- (3) Once an application has been accepted, no changes to the information on the application form will

- be permitted.
- (4) The examination fee already paid will not be refunded for any reason, except in the case of failure to submit the application documents, etc., or in the case of non-acceptance of the application.
- (5) The admission of the applicant who pass the examination with the expectation of fulfilling the prescribed requirements by September 2022 and fail to fulfill the requirements by September 2022 will be revoked.
- (6) Admission will be revoked if any irregularities in the submitted documents are found.
- (7) If you need a visa, you must obtain it by yourself.

9. Control and Prevention of Infectious Diseases

- (1)Regarding submission of a certificate demonstrating inoculation and an antibody test against measles and rubella:
 - Kobe University has implemented the Measles and Rubella Registration Policy, and all newly enrolled Kobe University students must submit one of the following three certificates (①, ②, or ③) to prevent a possible outbreak of measles and rubella on campus.
- ①A vaccination certificate to prove that you were inoculated against measles and rubella (twice each).
- ② A vaccination certificate to prove that you were inoculated with measles and rubella vaccines each within the last five years.
- ③An antibody certificate verifying that you have sufficient antibody titer in your blood (refer to the chart next page) to prevent the development of measles and rubella, based on the results of an antibody test performed within the last five years.
- *For ① and ②, it can be a combined vaccine of measles and rubella vaccines (e.g., MR vaccine).
- * For ① and ②, the certificate must be issued by an accredited medical institution and state the type of vaccine and the date of inoculation.
- *For ③, the certificate must specify the measuring method and the measured values of antibody titer in your blood (refer to the next page), and it must satisfy the judging standard listed in the chart. A blood test report sheet itself can be accepted for submission. If the antibody titer in your blood is insufficient, you must receive the necessary vaccination, and submit either ① or ②.
- * You may submit a combination of 1, 2, and 3 (e.g., 1 for measles, and 3 for rubella).
- * If the antibody titer level is below requirements, yet you cannot be inoculated with vaccines for some reason (e.g., illness or body composition), please submit an official document (for example, a certificate issued by the doctor) explaining why.

<Submission Period and Place of Submission>

Successful applicants enrolling in October.
 Submit the certificate when you register at the Medical Center for Student Health (Rokkodai) during the routine medical check-up scheduled for early October.

Measuring Methods and Judging Standards for Protective Antibodies in Blood

	Measuring Method	Judging Standard	Remarks
	IgG – EIA method	8.0≦ positive	Positive result by one of these three methods.
Measles	PA method	256x ≦ positive	
	NT method	$4.0x \leq positive$	
Rubella	HI method IgG – EIA	32x ≦ positive 8.0≦ positive	Positive result by one of these two methods.
Nubella	method	8.0≦ positive	(HI method is recommended)

Make sure the above methods are followed when the antibody titer is measured in your blood. The protective antibody value differs according to the measuring method used. Please note that the judging standards are higher than the usual standards used at medical institutions.

When you visit a doctor at a medical institution, make sure you present this guidebook so your doctor can issue the necessary certificate(s). (Please make sure you confirm with your doctor the measuring methods and judging standards when measuring the antibody titer in your blood.)

- * Points to Consider when Submitting a Certificate:
- ① Please submit the original certificate and one set of copies (A4 size).
- ② If the certificate is written in a language other than Japanese or English, please attach a document that shows either a Japanese or English translation.
