(1) What does the sentence (1) "I was all right" mean in this conversation?

- A. Sir Nevile Bland was a reasonable man.
- B. Sir Nevile Bland was suitable for the job.
- C. Nicholas Elliott was suitable for the job.
- D. Nicholas Elliott's father was reliable.

(2) What can you *not* infer from the description (2) "They were as close as two heterosexual, upper-class, mid-century Englishmen could be"?

- A. They were both heterosexual males.
- B. They were of approximately the same age.
- C. They shared the same social background.
- D. They were extremely close.

(3) What does the author think of the chapter referred to in (3)?

- A. It is brilliant.
- B. Elliott works hard in this chapter.
- C. The chapter is very well-written but too short.
- D. Macintyre's chapter is better than Elliott's or Philby's.

(4) What is it that Philby thought British intelligence was doing when he (4) "sens[ed] that British intelligence was closing in on him"?
