

Instructions

- (1) GSICS Working Paper Series is for speedy publication of research results prior to their submission to peer-reviewed journals and without being characterized as duplicate submission.
- (2) Those eligible for publication of a GSICS Working Paper are:
 - (a) Faculty members of GSICS, including visiting and invited scholars and researchers officially affiliated with GSICS;
 - (b) Those persons recommended by a GSICS faculty member, with the approval of the Editorial Board; and
 - (c) Under (b), if the person seeking publication is a graduate student, the recommending GSICS faculty member prepares document explaining the reasons and appropriateness of using the GSICS Working Paper Series for such publication, with the approval of the Editorial Board based on the document.
- (3) All contributions must be presented in their final form.
 - Language: English
 - 1 Page: 36 lines, A4, Paginate
 - Margin: top/bottom 34mm each, right/left 25mm each
 - Line feed: 18pt (Semi-double-space)
 - Font: Times, Times New Roman[Word], 10.5pt
 - Endnote should be placed after the main text, then References.
 - Figure, Chart and Table should be placed after References if you would not insert them in the text.
