

Guidelines for Submission of Master's Thesis

Students who wish to submit their Master's Theses or Research Papers for examination shall submit them in accordance with these Guidelines (Research Paper is a paper on a specific topic of research).

1. Deadline for Submission of Master's Thesis

The deadline for the submission of your Master's Thesis is 5:00 pm on July 15 for completion in September and 5:00 pm on January 31 for completion in March.

If the deadline falls on a weekend or holiday, it will be postponed to the next business day.

Submissions after the deadline will not be accepted.

2. Deadline for Submission of the Title of Master's Thesis

Those who wish to submit their Master's Theses in July must bring the Title of the Master's Thesis form to the Academic Affairs Office in GSICS by April 15 (for those who submit their master's theses in January, by October 31 of the preceding year).

If the deadline falls on a weekend or holiday, it will be postponed to the next business day.

Submissions after the deadline will not be accepted.

3. Preparing the Thesis

(1) The thesis must be written in English.

(2) A Summary is required. It should be no more than one page, using A4 paper.
(Times New Roman, 12 pt, minimum of 27 lines/page)

(3) The calculation of the length of the thesis includes the table of contents, text, footnotes, and graphs. References are not included. The minimum length is as follows: (Also refer to 4. Submission Format)

(4) Thesis and Research Paper for a Master of Economics

More than 20 pages using A4 paper.

(Times New Roman, 12 pt, minimum of 27 lines/page, Single-side printing)

(5) Thesis for Master of Laws, Political Science and International Studies

More than 30 pages using A4 paper.

(Times New Roman, 12 pt, minimum of 27 lines/page, Single-side printing)

(6) Research Paper for Master of Laws, Political Science and International Studies

More than 20 pages using A4 paper.

(Times New Roman, 12 pt, minimum of 27 lines/page, Single-side printing)

4. Submission Format

Master's Thesis: four copies, one original with a hard cover, and three copies.

Research Paper: three copies, one original with a hard cover, and two copies.

For details, see the 'Format of Thesis' on the next page.

The date of submission, title of thesis, name of faculty, name of department, name of academic adviser for the research, student ID number, and student's name must appear on the front cover.

In addition, a copy of the summary(one page) must be submitted.
